

The Reci-Piece Project: A Shared Meal Pottery Experiment

The Reci-Piece Project makes locally made pottery accessible, communal, and mobile in an effort to encourage community members to prepare and share meals, recipes, memories, and cultural traditions with one another.

Follow the steps below to “check out” (like a library book) a piece of locally made pottery to bring home, prepare and serve a meal, and document the experience through photos, recipes, and reflections on the experience.

10 Steps

To Share Your Story



1. Check out your favorite piece from the collection by local artist, Linda Holliday of Holliday Pottery. Take the piece home and carefully unpack it.
2. Make a dish that is meaningful to you, your family, community or culture.
3. Place the food in the pottery piece(s).
4. Take a picture of the prepared dish (with and/or without your family members in the photo).
5. Eat and enjoy! Pay attention to where the conversation goes for **Step 7!**
6. Wash the vessel(s) BY HAND with mild dishwashing soap.
7. Write down the recipe and a paragraph as to why you selected this dish and its meaning to you, your family, or your family history. Include a reaction to the shared meal experience:
 - What is something you learned from someone at your table?
 - What did it feel like to participate in this experience and share it with others in our region?
8. Send pictures, story paragraphs and recipe to info@sproutmn.com with the subject: “My Shared Meal.” You may also turn this information in with the returned pottery.
9. Safely re-pack the piece. Return the pottery and instructions to Sprout Growers & Makers Marketplace **two weeks** from the date checked out.
